Safe Distance from Special Mark buoys indicating a Wreck

The Ports and Yachting Directorate, Transport Malta, would like to bring to the attention of all mariners that further to Notice to Mariners Nos. 32 of 2010, 23 of 2011, 19 of 2013, 13 of 2016 and 27 of 2017, the following is a consolidated list where a Special Mark Buoy has been placed with a consolidated safe distance.
